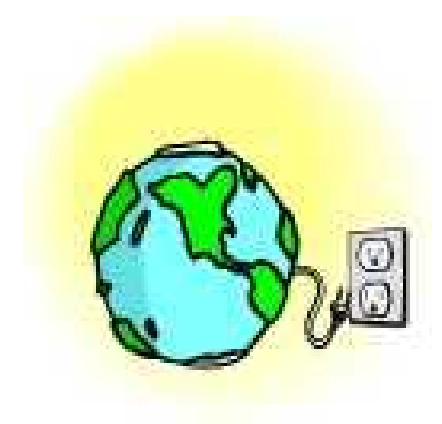

The majority of those journals are subscribed to by the main Library in Galway, but are available to Letterfrack students in electronic format on the Internet. Some of the journals allow back issue searching and show the full text of articles. Others may just give title and details of the article. If you have the bibliographical details of an article and would like to request it from the main Library in Galway, please contact the Library staff. Here's just a selection of journals available to you on the Internet:

## **BUSINESS & HUMANITIES**

### **HARVARD BUSINESS REVIEW**

[www.hbr.org](http://www.hbr.org)

You can look at articles taken from the most recent issue. You may also browse through articles from a selection of headings/topics or perform a keyword search. Full text of articles is not available online but all back issues from 1975 in bound volumes are held in the main Galway campus.

### **ECONOMIST**

[www.economist.com](http://www.economist.com)

The Economist online allows you to search their archive by keyword. The username is 'galwaymayo' and the password is 'library'. You will need to input these if you wish to 'buy' full text articles. The Economist online also provides an email alerting service.

### **INVESTORS CHRONICLE**

For access to the archive you will need a user id and password. Again, these are 'galwaymayo' and 'library'.

### **TIME MAGAZINE**

A searchable database featuring an archive of this year to date and last year. You may also browse by issue.

### **FORBES**

This contains full text of articles from the archive of Forbes magazine back to 1996.

### **PEOPLE MANAGEMENT**

Upon access, you may search the current issue or the archive of back issues which at present dates back to January 1998. The website contains the entire contents of the most recent issue as well as links to Human Resources sites elsewhere on the Internet and a 'law at work' section which looks at various legal HR issues. It also contains book reviews and opinion sections as well as an advanced 'job search' feature where you can search by category of position required or 'all' vacancies. Another feature is a specialist news section.

This site is an excellent resource for anybody interested in the personnel/HR areas.
